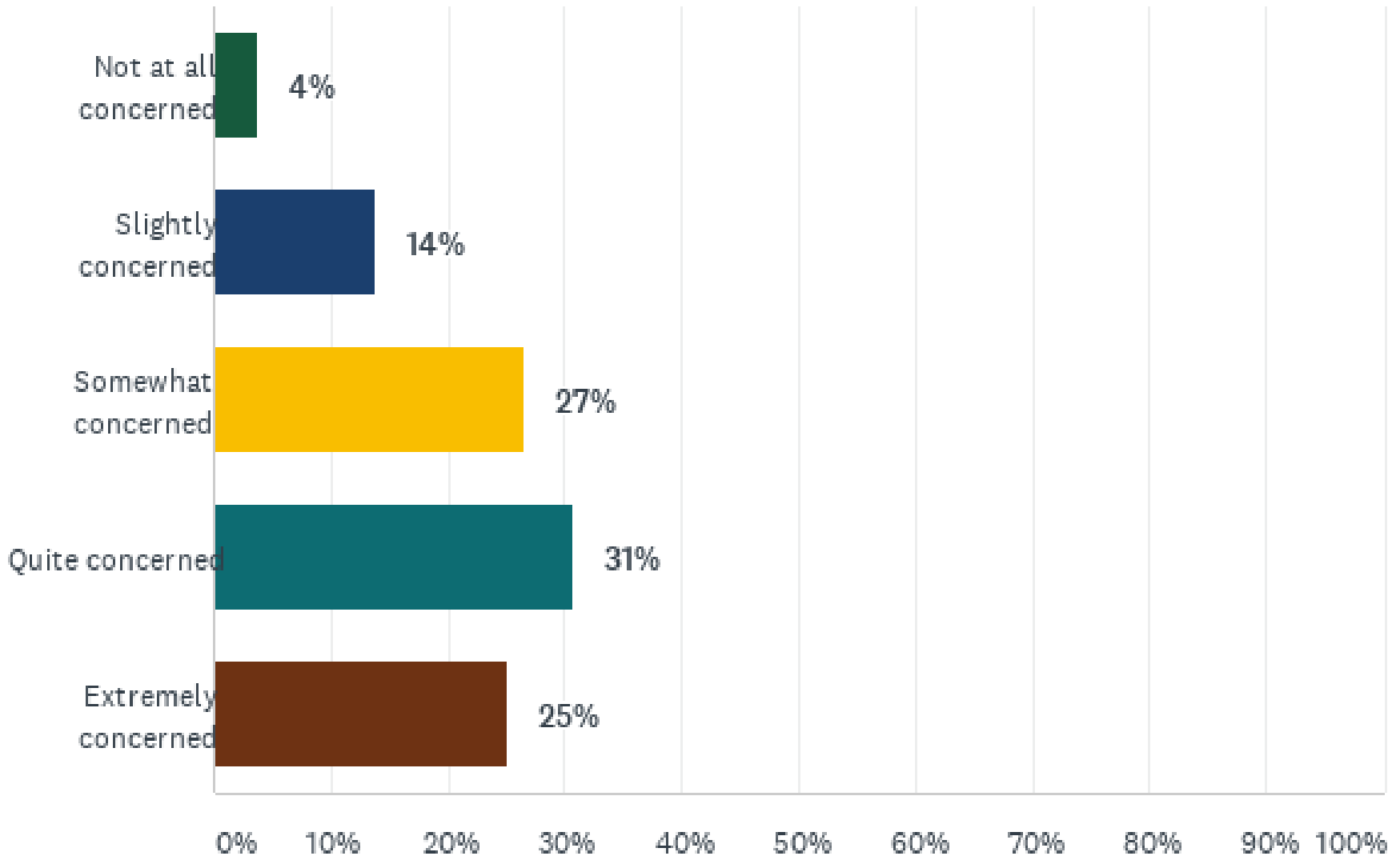

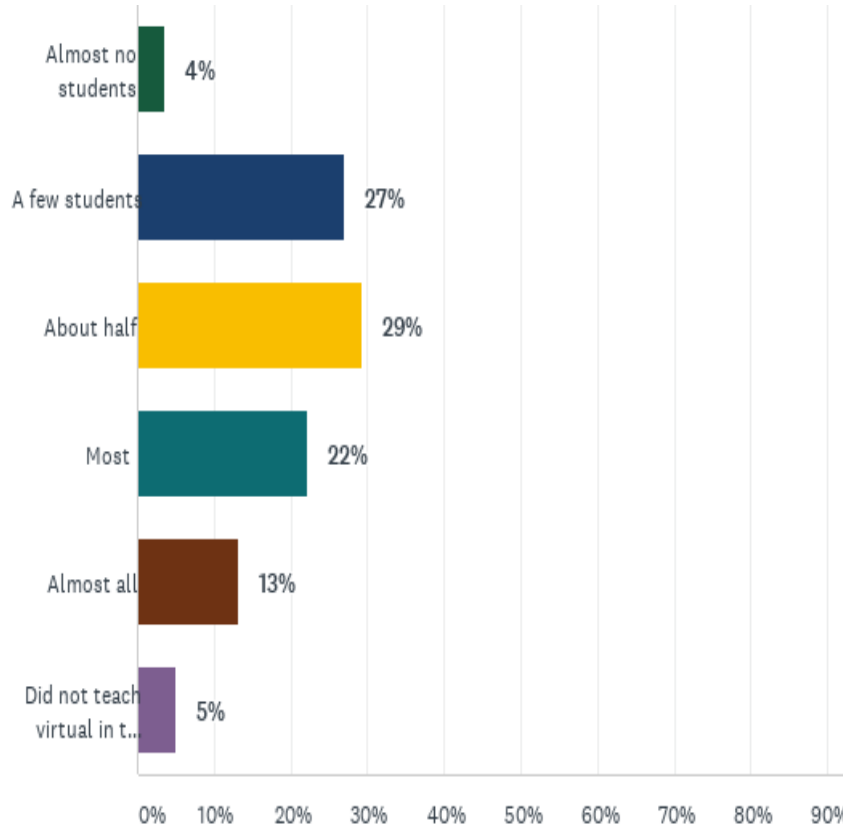

How concerned are you about students' academic growth right now?

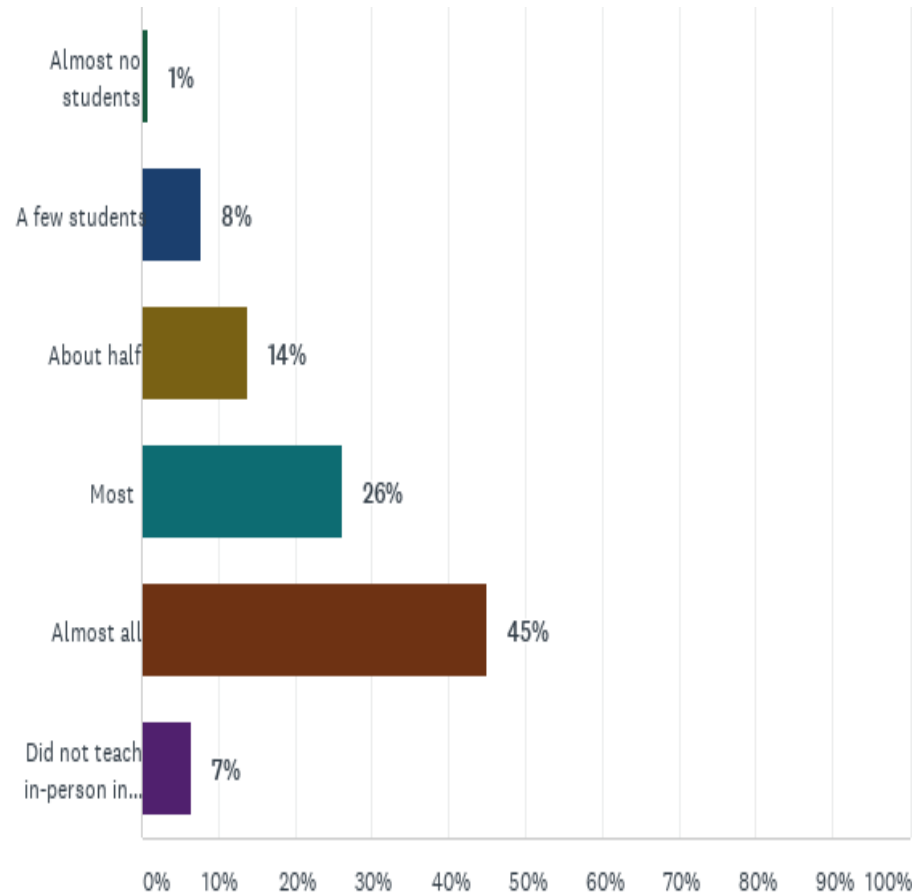


Student Engagement- TA Survey

When providing instruction in the last year, how many of your students regularly participated in your virtual classes?



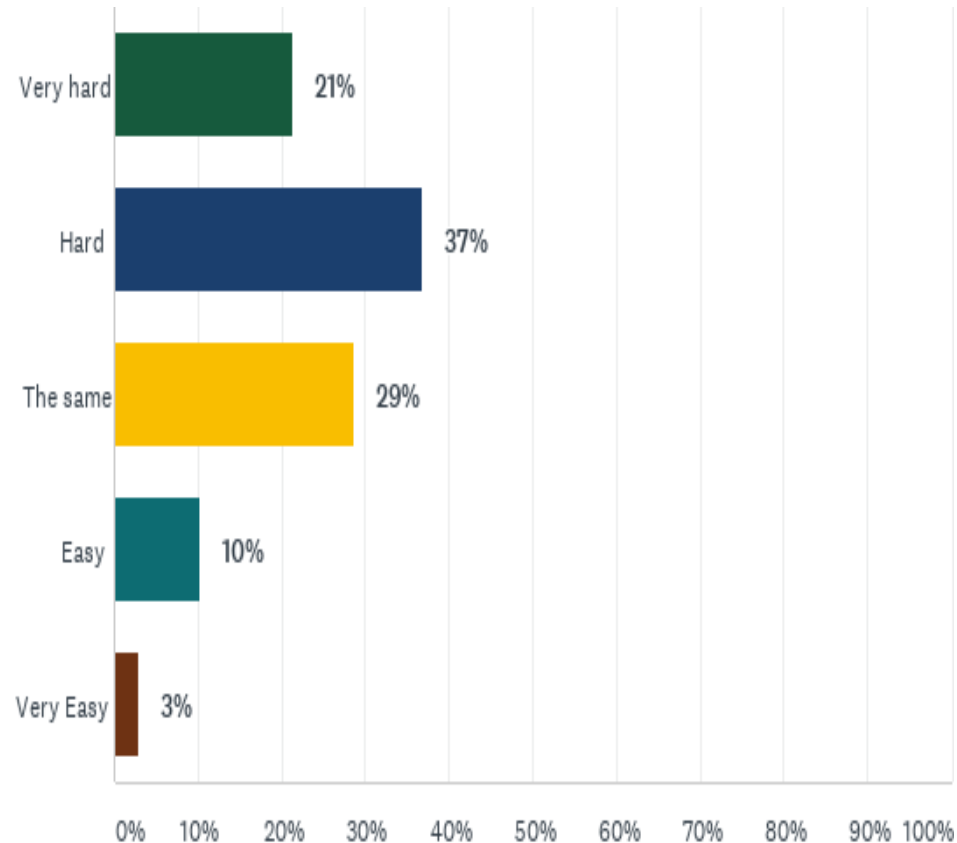
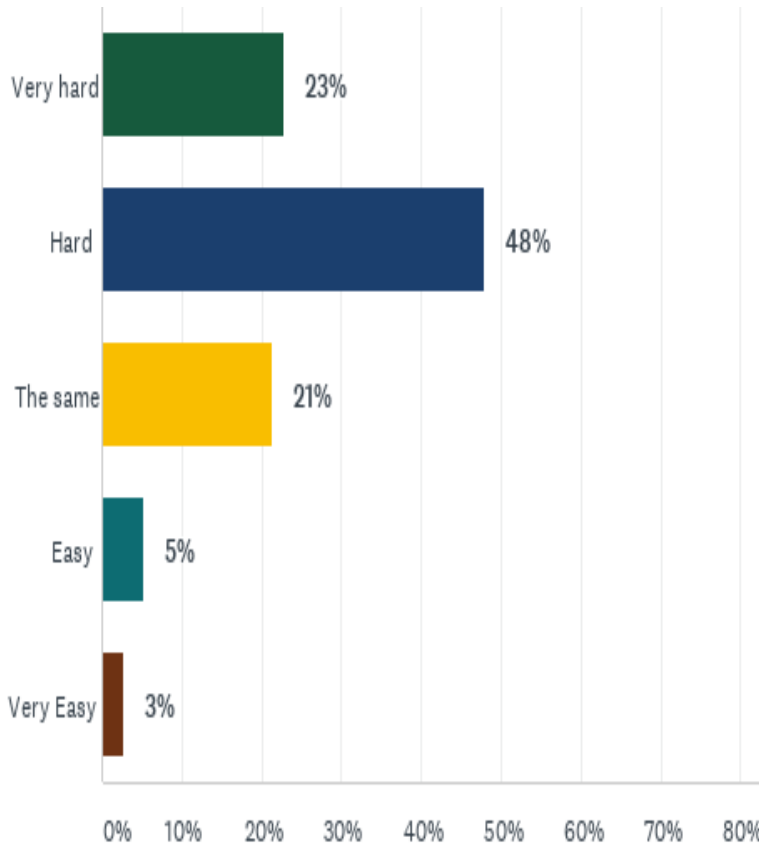
When providing instruction in the last year, how engaged have students been in your in-person classes?

- ✓ Exit: Proficiency on AZELLA – Overall Proficiency Level of Proficient (Proficient score in Reading, Writing, **and** Total Combined)

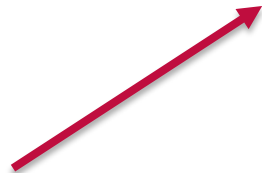
